In 2018, Ace Mart opened a 215,000 square foot distribution center with 54 loading docks in Schertz to support the growing business. The company also owns and operates ADI, an ice machine and microwave distributor in a six state area. Three years ago, the company launched an import business of specialty products for the foodservice industry.

Ace Mart is owned by Carl, his brother Paul and sister Norma, all three of whom are still active in day to day operations. It's a source of pride to also note that 5 of the Gustafson's children, representing the third generation, are actively participating in the business.

Ace Mart Restaurant Supply has been recognized nationally as one of the top 15 foodservice equipment and supply dealers in the US. With 400 full time employees, annual revenue for 2018 was \$130 million.
